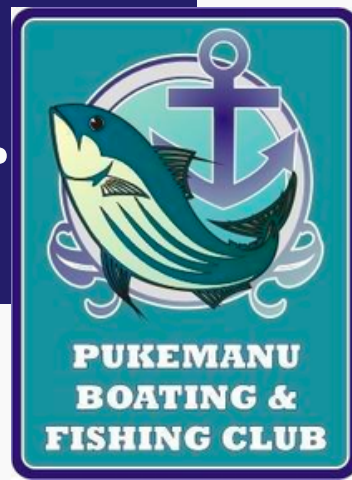

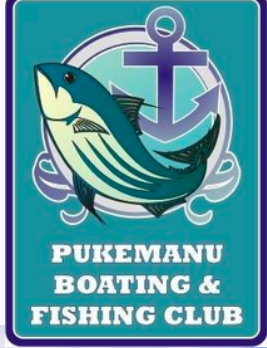

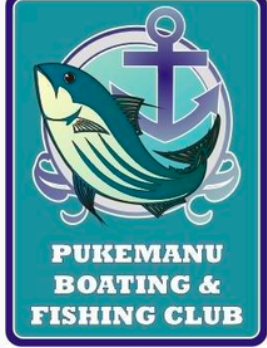

...and of course, some 'bullshit' ensued warranting the bullshit trophy @ the Palace! (note the time on the clock!)





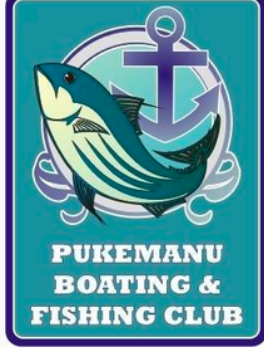
Pukemanu v Ngawi Challenge

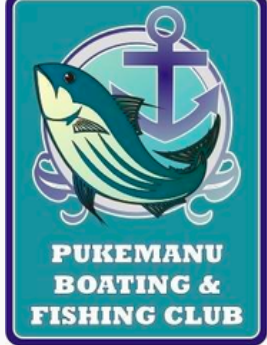

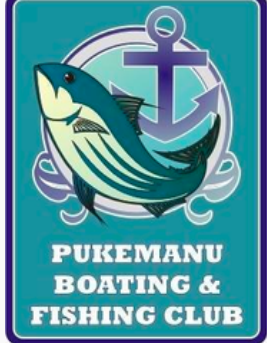
In other Pukemanu news...

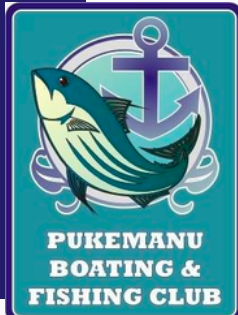
