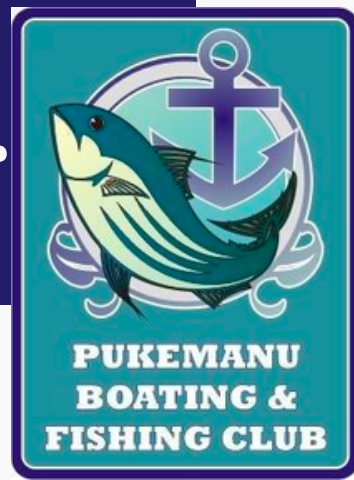

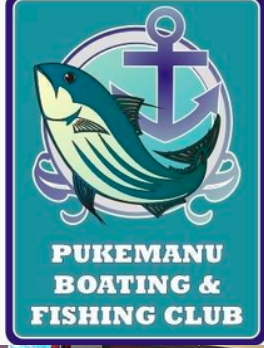
December club weekend was a no fish with only one boat getting out. The next club weekend is the 14th and 15th of January.

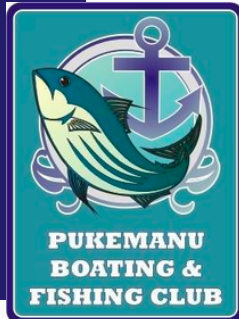
